BANDHAVGARH OneStop

A 9 day tour to Bandhavgarh to see the most evocative of the world's endangered big cats, the Royal Bengal Tiger. The itinerary is designed to use internal flights on the journey to Bandhavgarh, and is scheduled so that clients can combine this with the Yala itinerary.

1on1 TOURS TO BANDHAVGARH

Pete is in Bandhavgarh at the moment with clients on one of our Bandhavgarh 1on1 tours. The sightings from the elephant have been spectacular, and the special permission for early and late entry have been really effective in seeing the animals before the other jeeps arrive. Sightings have included Mirchani and her three cubs, a tiger kill, and 10 minutes with a huge sloth bear less than 15 metres from the jeep.

TIGER NEWS in BANDHAVGARH

Kulwah and Bandar (B2) have been squaring up on the east side of the forest. Both tigers have been vying for control of Goradamon, which has always been one of B2's favourite spots. One afternoon both ended up in the same place. A lot of roaring and swiping of paws followed, before Kaluha rolled over and submitted. Amazing to see a 450lb tiger rolling over like a domestic cat.

Unfortunately, Chakradhara killed a cow near one of the villages, and a teenage girl out collecting mowa in the dark disturbed the tiger and was killed. A sad time for the village and a worrying one for the tiger.

Jhurjura's new 3 month old cubs are now being seen near Rajbhera dam.
